- Correction to Tech tip: Pinhole filler



I got it WRONG. According to Darryl Hudec, that fibral lite is a stranded filler used in place of micro ballon's. It will have pinholes and minor imperfections. It is strong and won't crack.

Jp 202 is the filler of pinholes. Spray on and watch them disappear. You can load it on and

sands easily and dries fast. The JP375 is a primer with hardener that can be used over the 202 which is a Primer Surfacer. The 202 has to be over coated with a primer sealer.

~~Darryl Hudec and Ray Ward report that Fibral Lite by U-pol is a superior pinhole filler for cowlings and other fiberglass parts.~~

They also report that if you use a small drill bit to chamfer, or open up, the pinholes slightly it is much easier to get the filler to properly fill the hole. Otherwise air will be trapped in the pinhole which will cause the pinhole to reopen during sanding.
